From Hailsham travel east on A271 to Herstmonceux. At Herstmonceux turn left at mini roundabout at the Woolpack Inn. After 1/2 mile turn right into Chilsham Lane. After 1 1/2 miles Merryweather's Herbs will be on your right, shortly after you cross a small white bridge.
